# Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP)

- 2012-13 Participation
- Employment Ontario Information System (EOIS-APPR)
- Ontario College of Trades



# 2012-13 OYAP Participation

- **24,209** OYAP participants
  - Motive 22%
  - Construction 17%
  - Industrial 7%
  - Service 54%
- **5,708** OYAP apprentices (i.e. participants with registered training agreements)



# 2013-14 Audit & Accountability Requirements

## New Requirements:

- Boards with more than \$100,000 in OYAP funding are also required to submit an auditor's report for OYAP. Please see memo posted on the EOPG and 2013-14 Audit & Accountability Requirements.



# Employment Ontario Information System for Apprenticeship (EOIS-APPR)

## 2013-14 EOIS Data Entry by School Boards:

- **December 31, 2013:** 2013-14 semester one OYAP participants.
- **December 31, 2013:** complete the participation of all students who graduated/left high school prior to August 2013.

Note: If there are OYAP students who left high school without graduating, please withdraw them from OYAP in the EOIS-APPR.



# Employment Ontario Information System for Apprenticeship (EOIS-APPR)

Note: training modules are currently being updated to reflect changes related to the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009.



# Ontario College of Trades (OCOT)

## New OYAP Participant Application Form:

- On April 8, 2013, a new OYAP Application Form was posted on the EOPG. This form incorporates references to the College of Trades and OCTAA.
- Other revisions to the form were included as requested by school boards:
  - School name
  - Teacher name and telephone
  - Contact at placement site (Section 2, Request for RTA)



# Ontario College of Trades (OCOT)

As of April 8, 2013:

- OYAP participants without RTAs are not required to become members of OCOT
- OYAP participants with RTAs (i.e., OYAP apprentices) must become members of OCOT, however they are exempt from membership fees while they are in OYAP
  - They are also exempt from appearing in the public register, and from being called before any of the OCOT committees on conduct and fitness to practise
  - These exemptions end when the OYAP apprentice completes or withdraws from OYAP





# Ontario College of Trades (OCOT)

## New RTAs on or after April 8, 2013:

- OYAP participants with training agreements registered on or after April 8, 2013, must become members of OCOT within 90 days of the registration date on the training agreement.
- If new apprentices do not become members within the required time period, the RTA will be cancelled (notification will be sent to the apprentice and the sponsor.)



# Completion of OYAP

- When OYAP participants with an RTA graduate and leave secondary school, they will be required to pay a membership fee to OCOT if they continue to have an RTA
- OCOT will send them an invoice on the anniversary date of their initial membership
