Student Selection

- **Don Bosco School History**

- School has developed a strong program in Hospitality & Tourism
- New Facility has just been constructed & staff is in place
- Located such that it can fairly easily serve Airport Strip Hotels

- **Process**

- Pilot Project Application – June'06
- Pilot project approval – October '06
- Appoint some one to get it going (Mid November)
- Work with School Staff (esp. Guidance Head & VP)
- Co Ordinate with Humber & Board personnel

- **Student Eligibility**

- Must they be going to Humber next year
- Must they be in College bound Courses
- Do we only approach those students in the HRT program at Don Bosco

- **Response**

- Gauge response from Don Bosco Students
- Liaison with Guidance about Student status & questions

- **Going to Other Schools**

- Approach principals of other schools in area with proximity to Humber (North Campus)
- Meet with students from other schools that are recommended (5 – 4 accepted)
- Transfer students to Bosco - **** Transfer them back to Home School for Graduation**

Issues with Students

- I need an extra mandatory course (usually English ,Mathematics)
- I have or have not done Co op before - does it matter?
- Travel time to Humber
- How do I get there ? TTC? Parking Costs?
- Want to try College but maybe not HRT?
- I have Workplace level courses, can I take this program?
- Can I take this but go to another College and will the credit be recognized there?
- Certification in some areas (Smart Serve, Safe food etc.) & costs for these certifications.

Other Issues

- Late Project Approval
- Less students than hoped for (13 vs 20)
- Course Code for OSSD & Scheduling
- Staffing Issues (Board & Federation Rules)
- Supervision (Champion?) at the local high school
- Continuity for Next Year ? Phase 11
- Course Selection Process (Starts Now!)
